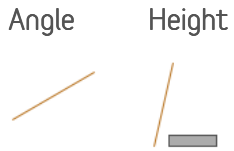

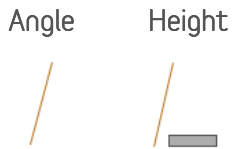

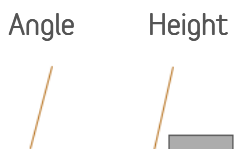
Climb right on cool slopers and pinches

Same start as For Her Pleasure and climb left to and up the arete

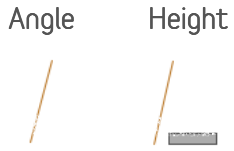

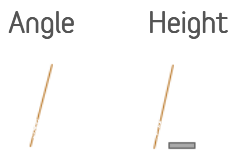
Climb straight up from the same start as For Her Pleasure.

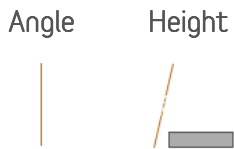


10. Male Pattern Baldness
